PRICING INFORMATION

STUDENT FINANCE: The baseline cost of total trip is \$1605 for a student in a quad hotel room. The MHS music boosters will do their best to help offset the cost of the trip; however, due to the significant nature of this experience and the number of students attending this might only put a small dent in the overall cost.

The first deposit will be \$150 and due on March 22. The payment plan will be presented in full at the parent meeting on February 26.

The cost of the Disney trip will be in addition to the \$650 competitive marching season fee. The competitive marching fee must be paid in full prior to the final deposit of the Disney trip.

PARENT FINANCE: Parent packages will be available; however, will not include lodging or travel. These are ballpark prices:

Admission to Thanksgiving Dinner and Dessert Party - \$153 3 Day Park Hopper and Thanksgiving Dinner & Dessert Party - \$610

TRIP INSURANCE: Trip Insurance is available so if you need to cancel for any reason there will be a full refund. More information regarding insurance will be available at the meeting on February 26.

FUNDRAISING: There will be a spring fundraiser for students to raise money to offset their individual cost. Students will have the opportunity to earn over \$700 for their personal trip fees plus incentives.

We are also looking for more fundraising options for the late summer and early fall. It's our goal to give all students the opportunity to have this once in a lifetime Disney experience.

REHEARSAL AND PREPARATION

Once the competitive schedule is finalized the rehearsal schedule for Disney will be released. We will not rehearse for Disney during competitive rehearsals such as Tuesday Nights or Saturday. Music and color guard work for the performance may be rehearsed during 5th, 6th, and 7th hours after the competitive season has concluded. Preparation for Disney will NOT interfere with the production of the marching show.
